The Hulopoe Beach Park is very special to all of us here on Lanai. There is a need to ensure that it is always protected and taken care of. Recently there have been concerning incidents at the beach park, such as damaged items, vandalism, and areas not cleaned up after. There are times that beach users may have concerns and don't know who to voice their concerns too or cannot access a Park Ranger right away. In conjunction with Pūlama Lāna'l, we have created a reporting system that allows beach goers to report concerns as soon as they are happening.
